1. Who are we?

2. What personal data do we collect?

4. What do we use your personal data for?

We use your data for the following purposes:

- **To improve your website experience**: by analyzing usage patterns and preferences to optimize our website.
- **For marketing purposes**: such as sending newsletters, offers, or other marketing communications (only if you have given consent).
- To comply with legal obligations: such as tax regulations or other legal requirements.

5. What is our legal basis for processing your data?

Under the GDPR, we rely on the following lawful bases for processing your personal data:

- **Consent**: when you have given us permission (e.g., for marketing emails or cookies).
- **Contractual necessity**: when processing is required to fulfil a contract, such as completing a purchase.
- **Legal obligations**: when we are legally required to process your data.
- **Legitimate interest**: when we have a legitimate interest, such as improving our website or preventing fraud.

We only share your data with third parties when necessary to provide our services or when legally required. These may include:

- **Payment processors**: to process your transactions.
- Web hosting and IT service providers: to manage and maintain our website.
- Marketing platforms: for sending newsletters or advertising (where applicable).
- **Legal authorities**: when we are legally obligated to disclose data.

7. How long do we keep your data?

We do not retain your personal data longer than necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, unless a longer retention period is required by law. Data collected for marketing purposes is stored until you unsubscribe or withdraw your consent.

8. Your rights regarding personal data

You have several rights regarding the personal data we hold about you:

- **Right of access**: You can request a copy of the personal data we hold about you.
- **Right to rectification**: You can request correction of inaccurate or incomplete data.
- **Right to erasure**: You can request the deletion of your data (the "right to be forgotten").
- **Right to restrict processing**: You can request us to limit the processing of your data.

- **Right to data portability**: You can request to receive your data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format.
- **Right to object**: You may object to the processing of your data for certain purposes, such as marketing.
